The second session is extended after a break to complete the online assessment. This is under exam conditions and will be completed online under supervision of the tutor.


You must access the course via a laptop, desktop (with enabled webcam) or tablet. The use of a mobile phone device is not acceptable.

Your tutor will liaise with you prior to the course to make sure that all is working before the formal session.


# Assessment THE MOST IMPORTANT BIT

The ROLO assessment is now hosted on the BALI ROLO platform. You will need to register before the course to enable you to sit the course and complete the on-line assessment.

Go to the ROLO website here <a href="https://rolo-online.org.uk/login/index.php">https://rolo-online.org.uk/login/index.php</a> to access the ROLO login and registration page. You will need to create a new account.




- At this point you will enter you details and submit them.
- You will receive an email from BALI (David Price via RO) confirming your request. You
  MUST reply to or confirm that email to be live on their system. It is the hyperlink in
  blue in the image below.




 When you have completed the registration, you MUST email us to let us know that you are registered fully on the system.

When registered fully, we can make you live in the system and you **CAN** access your dashboard by logging in to the ROLO site with your username and password. There you have 2 pages, the first for the final assessment and the other is Course Resources.



Here you will see your resources and the sample test. The sample test password is **Test** 

You can look at this before the course and attempt the simple SAMPLE ASSESSMET. This should give you confidence on the day for the real assessment. You will also see your "workbook" which will be used through the training session. It is under the dropdown when you click on resources. The best one to use is the editable pdf. It is important that you have been able to access this prior to joining the course.



On the day of the assessment you will be given a new password to complete the test. You get 30 minutes to complete the 35 questions and 45 minutes if you require Reasonable adjustment.

Access and look through your resources and perhaps complete the sample test. You must be able access this prior to the course.
